

Parish of Wiverton in the Vale

Electoral Roll Report 2019

The electoral roll, produced as one for the whole Parish, was revised from scratch in the run up to this APCM, according to church law which requires that a new roll be drawn up every 6 years.

It now stands at 135.

The significant reduction in numbers from the last reported figure of 189 is mostly due to the dropping off of people not resident in the parish. There used to be 46 'Non Residents' as prospective wedding couples living outside the parish used to be required to be on the electoral roll if they had no other qualifying connection; this has changed so that now, provided they worship regularly with us for 6 months, those people no longer have to be on the electoral roll.

The remaining 7 'Non Residents' on the new electoral roll are regular worshippers who live relatively near by, such as Katharine and Edward!

There have been an encouraging number of younger people added to the roll, to offset others who have moved away or not taken up the invitation to re-enrol.
