What's happening	<p>The Deanery Walk is open to all ages.</p> <p>We will begin at St. Luke's Church in Kinoulton with Morning Prayer and breakfast and walk along the canal path through Cropwell Bishop where there will be a stop for lunch and then continue to All Saints Church in Cotgrave for Evening Prayer and Afternoon Tea.</p> <p>People are encouraged to join us for all or part of the walk. As the canal path is very accessible and crosses several roads, there are opportunities for people to join us for however much or little of the walk they can make.</p> <p>There will be a number of pauses along the route for prayer/reflection. We are also going to provide a booklet with all of the details for the day to give to the walkers.</p>

	<p>Approximate times</p> <p>09:30 Breakfast cobs at Kinoulton</p> <p>10:00 Morning Prayer</p> <p>10:30 Start of walk</p> <p>11:30 Reflective stop near Owthorpe, Little Retreat Day Spa</p> <p>12:30 Lunch at Memorial Hall, Cropwell Bishop with Brownies</p> <p>13:20 Reflective thought then set off towards Cotgrave</p> <p>14:30 Reflective stop near A46</p> <p>16:00 Reflective stop in Cotgrave country park</p> <p>16:30 Afternoon tea at All Saints Church, Cotgrave & Evening Prayer</p> <p>We are planning a ‘treasure hunt’ along the way for any children involved and ask that people bring with them water, lunch and nibbles for the road; tea, coffee and refreshments will be provided at the stops in Kinoulton, Cropwell Bishop and Cotgrave.</p> <p><i>Please may we have expressions of interest for the breakfast at Kinoulton and tea at Cotgrave by end August, and also whether participants will be doing the full walk or just part of it. This is for transport and catering purposes (any dietary requirements will also need to be noted). There will be a minibus for transporting people from Cotgrave to Kinoulton for the start of the walk but again we will require numbers so that this can be properly organised.</i></p> <p>NOTE: <i>The Walk is approximately 8 miles in length along level, well maintained paths and will be taken at a reasonable pace. However, the walk is undertaken at the Walker’s own risk. Walkers are asked to act responsibly, ensure the safety of all members of their party, including children and animals, and be fit to safely participate.</i></p>
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
