### LETTERS From the Rectory and Beyond

### **REFLECTIONS by Hilary Tabron**

I wonder how many of you have followed any of the television series 'Trigger Point'? It's not comfortable watching, as the plot is punctuated with moments of high tension as a clock counts down on a bomb being deactivated, or sadly exploding with devasting, tragic consequences. Nothing can quite prepare the characters.

In a very different scenario, nothing can completely prepare Jesus and his followers for the events which will unfold as they journey towards Jerusalem for Passover.

"Now my soul is troubled..." So said Jesus in the Gospel passage we will hear this weekend. The words seem as much for himself and his heavenly Father as to the people around him. Jesus is burdened with a growing appreciation of his impending sacrifice, both knowing and dreading the ordeal to come. He's been trying to prepare his closest friends, but it's a confusing struggle for them.

Jesus himself grapples with how to deal with what's ahead, and wonders what he should say. "Father, save me from this hour."? But no, he knows that he must surrender to God's greater purpose and plan, and professes that to the people around him. Knowing that he is fulfilling God's will fortifies him.

Now we're beginning the final two weeks of Lent, known as Passiontide, shifting our focus from penitence towards sacrifice. Can we allow our souls to be troubled alongside Jesus, walking with him in a mystical way which spans the millennia? Can we be shocked and saddened and somehow experience this with Jesus, knowing that as we draw alongside Him, He draws alongside us? If are able, then sharing together in the Parish Retreat and the worship of Holy Week offers us ways of doing this. I'm looking forward to these and hope to see you there!
